## Program Mission



## What We Are

The Renewanation Virginia Scholarship Foundation is a division of Renewanation, a 501(c)(3) public charity, which engages individuals and businesses in Virginia in community transformation through the Education Improvement Scholarships Tax Credits Program, thereby enabling donors to receive qualified tax credits while providing eligible children in Virginia the opportunity to receive Christian worldview education.

## How to Participate

### 1. Determine Your Child's Eligibility

To qualify for assistance through the EISTCP program, a student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a resident of Virginia and (i) eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade or (ii) in the current school year has enrolled and attended a public school in the Commonwealth for at least one-half of the year or (iii) for the school year that immediately preceded his/her receipt of a foundation scholarship was enrolled and attended a public school in the Commonwealth for at least one-half of the year or (iv) is a prior recipient of a foundation scholarship or (v) for the school year that immediately preceded his/her receipt of a scholarship foundation scholarship was domiciled in a state other than the Commonwealth and did not attend a nonpublic school in the Commonwealth for more than one-half of the school year. (*A resident of Virginia means that the student meets the requirements of Section 22.1-3 of the Code of Virginia, for admission to a Virginia public school.*)
- Have a family household income that does not exceed 300 percent of the current federal poverty level, or in the case of special needs students, 400 percent of the federal poverty level with a written and filed IEP.
- Enroll in qualified school.

### 2. Find a Qualified School

- To become qualified, an eligible school must meet certain criteria. Visit our website at [vascholarshipfoundation.org](http://vascholarshipfoundation.org) for complete criteria.
- The Renewanation Virginia Scholarship Foundation only supports scholarships to qualified schools that also provide a thoroughly Christian education.

### 3. Apply For Enrollment

When applying for enrollment, parents should ask if the school qualifies for and participates in the Virginia Education Improvement Scholarships Tax Credits Program.
